



Meal Program at WCSU Summer SOAK June 12, 2023

The WCUD School Nutrition Program will offer a Grab & Go breakfast and a regular school lunch service at the Summer SOAK program in July. Meals will be free for those students who qualify for Free & Reduced school meals. Those students who do not qualify for Free & Reduced school meals will need to pay for SOAK meals. This is different from the school year due to state and federal funding regulations for the Summer Food Service Program. Students may bring their own meals if you do not want them to access the available meal service. See payment information below.

Students who have qualified during the school year will continue to receive free SOAK meals. How does my child sign up for SOAK meals?

No prior sign up for breakfast is required. Students can access the breakfast options as they pass from the auditorium to their first morning sessions.

Lunch counts will be taken in the morning once your child gets into his/her morning session.

How do I pay for meals?

Breakfast \$3.50 Lunch \$5.00

Every student in our district has a meal account. When the student comes through the breakfast or lunch line, he/she will enter their meal number into the computer system.

You may bring a check to the main SOAK desk/office for funds to be placed on your child's account, or you can create an account (if you don't have one already) on myschoolbucks.com to pay online.

Offsite Meals

If your child is off site for the day, Grab & Go breakfast can still be accessed and bagged lunches can be requested.

Mini SOAK at WES

We will be delivering meals to WES for Mini SOAK. Prepacked Grab & Go Breakfasts will be available and lunches will be delivered for those students who order. Lunches will be prepacked with the main meal option, fruit, vegetable side and milk choices.

Menu & Meal Accommodations

Alternative to the Main Meal
